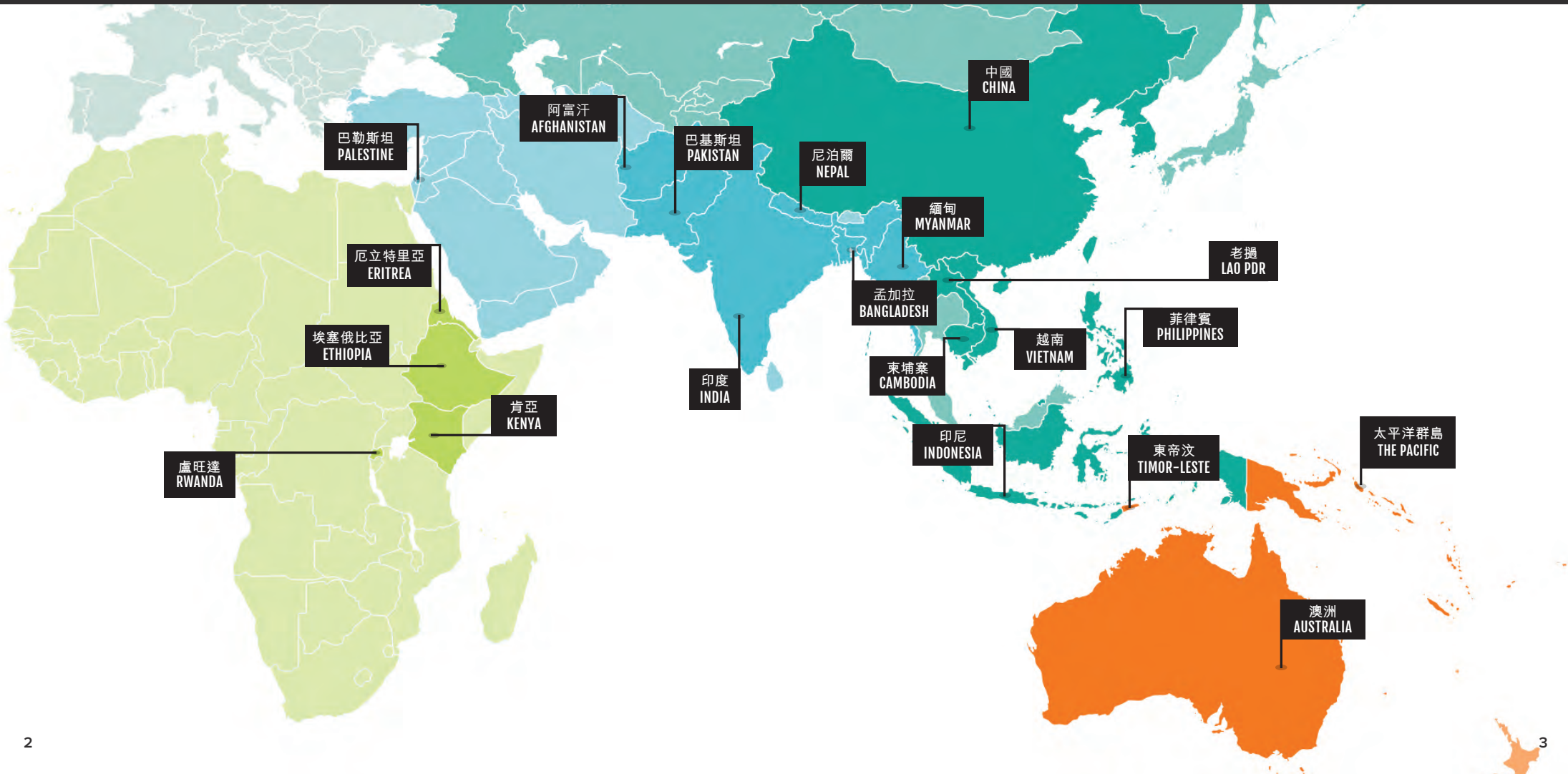

CONTINUING OUR COVID-19 RESPONSE

2020年新冠疫情在全球爆發，護瞳行動已努力不懈支援世界各地公共衛生系統，減輕新冠疫情帶來的重擔。在2021年我們未有停步，並因應疫情轉變，更靈活彈性處理眼疾服務。我們重點關注受疫情影響卻被社會遺忘的一群，致力確保在疫情下提供安全的眼科服務。

Since the outbreak of COVID-19 in 2020, we have started to ease the burden on public health systems by ensuring our programs remain flexible and agile. We focus on the marginalised groups who have suffered the most devastating impacts of COVID-19 and ensure eye care services continue to be delivered safely.

今年三月，護瞳行動在老撾首都萬象的國家眼科中心舉辦了外展服務。

今年67歲的Keo曾是工程人員，受白內障和翼狀胬肉（組織增生）的影響，視力越來越差，不得不停止工作。手術後，Keo激動地說：「術後第一天，我的視野就清晰多了。我可以數手指，甚至可以看到遠處的物件！」

在視力出現問題多年後，Keo十分期待重返工作崗位。感謝您的支持，Keo再一次找到了自己的人生價值！

In March, The Fred Hollows Foundation held an outreach event at the National Ophthalmology Centre in Vientiane, capital of Lao PDR.

Sixty-seven-year-old Keo was among those who underwent cataract surgery. A former mechanic, Keo stopped working as his vision became worse because of cataract and pterygium (a growth on the clear tissue of the eye). "Things are already much better just one day after my operation, and I can also see things from a distance now," he said.

Keo is looking forward to work again after many years of vision problems. Thanks to your support, Keo has found a new lease in life!

在過去的三年裡，40歲的Joshna一直看不清楚。視力不斷惡化，她失去了正常生活的能力。於是Joshna在護瞳行動於孟加拉的伙伴醫院尋求幫助，原來她患有嚴重的屈光不正。

幫助Joshna的方法很簡單，就是戴眼鏡。可是她很擔心別人的眼光和購買眼鏡的費用，因為現時全球仍有許多地方對戴眼鏡存在奇怪的歧視和偏見，女性更是首當其衝。幸好醫生的建議和開導釋除了她的擔憂。與此同時，護瞳行動亦為Joshna提供免費的眼鏡。

Joshna喜出望外，她終於可以回復正常的生活，看見可愛的孩子們了！

For the past three years, 40-year-old Joshna has been unable to see clearly. Due to deteriorating eyesight, she lost the ability to live a normal life. One day, she was diagnosed with severe uncorrected refractive error by our partner hospital in Barishal, Bangladesh.

Joshna was told to wear glasses, but she was worried about the cost and stigma. In many parts of the world, there is a social stigma about wearing glasses and this disproportionately affects women, making them less likely to wear them.

Thankfully, advice from specialists helped Joshna overcome her fears about wearing glasses and The Foundation provided them for free.

Joshna was overjoyed to return to her normal life and see her four daughters.

住在肯亞的Grace獨力撫養三名孩子。多年前，她在農場做苦力時，眼睛被石頭擊中，因此患上外傷性白內障。禍不單行，Grace更發現她最小的孩子，七歲的Nicholas也患上白內障，失去學習能力。可是她卻沒有辦法支付兒子的手術費用，令她絕望不已。

因為您的捐助，護瞳行動安排母子倆進行免費白內障手術，解除失明的枷鎖。

Grace is a single mother of three from Kenya. Years ago, she was hit in the eye with a rock and developed a traumatic cataract. Then Grace discovered her youngest child, seven-year-old Nicholas, had developed cataract himself and was struggling to see at school. Grace did not have enough money to afford surgery.

You helped Grace and Nicholas to receive free cataract surgery and avoid blindness for the rest of their lives.

They could see again! Nicholas went back to school and Grace is also more able to support her children than ever before!

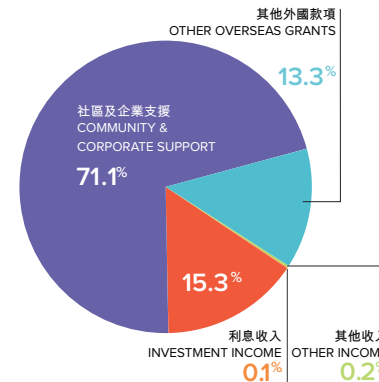

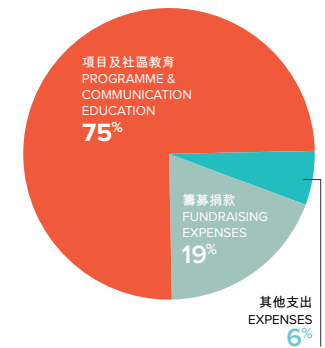

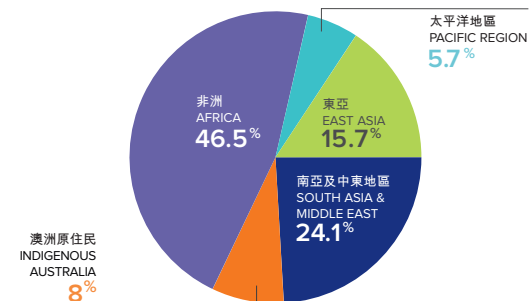
收入來源 SOURCE OF INCOME
